4. Treasurer Report

a. Financial Summary

The Financial summary was not reviewed as Jaylene Sandhar was *absent* from the meeting.

b. SEACAN – Quote \$5000

This container will be used for storage of tables and chairs, to better utilize indoor space for learning.

- PAC is willing to contribute to SEACAN costs. Quote for container is \$5000.
 PAC wishes to further discuss the split of costs for vote at the next PAC meeting.
- ii. Suggestion put forth to have this container painted by the mural artist.

c. Mural for exterior of gym – Quote \$5000.

d. School Hardship Fund - \$1500

Each year the PAC provides \$1500 for the school hardship fund. This money has been budgeted but not issued yet to the school. Sandeep will follow up with the school administration to receive a formal request for the funds.

e. Jess Dance Workshop - \$5000

PAC will cover the \$5000 cost of the Jess Dance workshops. \$4000 to be used from gaming funds. PAC voted to cover the additional \$1000 to be taken from the fine arts budget in order to cover full costs.

Sandeep motioned to approve the use of the additional \$1000 funds from the fine arts budget seconded by Erin Mah. PAC will request Jaylene to issue a cheque for \$5000 for Jess Dance for Friday January 19th.

f. Purchase of basketballs - \$1300

Sandeep motioned to approve \$1300 of funds from the gaming account for the purchase of basketballs. Ken Loy has seconded the motion.

g. Music equipment - \$500

Sandeep motioned to approve the \$500 funds from the gaming account for music equipment. Chris Ho seconded the motion.

h. Rock and Roll Workshop

Nona will confirm if this event is scheduled for this year and provide details to PAC.

i. PAC General Account

PAC is requesting parent's ideas of how to spend PAC funds from the General Account.
