- 1. Welcome—Erin
- 2. Review and approval of February Minutes—Erin
 - Motion: approve Feb 2020 minutes as presented.

Moved: Erin, seconded: CC Chang. Motion carried. No one opposed.

- 3. PAC Exec Updates
 - Erin PAC updates: Started a new format of communication with parents and sent the first newsletter on March 1st. Along with this we will now be posting all minutes and agendas to the school website so that parents can read them there. Erin asked that anyone who has submissions for the newsletter send them to her before April 1st.
 - Erin McRoberts Scholarship information was received and has been actioned by Brandi. She provided the general email account as the best place to reach the PAC for next year, rather than her personal email. No action required by PAC for this year.
 - Erin Discussion around reminding parents of recent recommendations for children to refrain from playing on the school playground. Erin will include in newsletter.
 - Erin Update on Neighbourhood Grant application: submission was completed before
 the deadline and if we are successful the grant will be used to fund the Meet the
 Teacher event in September. Erin reminded everyone that the Survey is still open and
 the link is posted on the PAC section of the website. We have only had 17 responses so
 far and are hoping now that parents are home they will have time to complete it.
 - Erin A parent brought our attention to another available grant from Best Buy. Most of
 the information for it has to come from the school and the grant has to be endorsed by
 the Principal. The grant information was forwarded to Sarah (VP) and she will look into
 it. PAC will assist if needed.
 - Diana There is still chips, drinks and snacks that are in the concession area that will likely expire before next school year. Recommended that we donate it all to the Richmond Food Bank for families in need. Diana will coordinate with Whiteside staff to attend the school to pick it up and make the donation.
 - Motion: approve donation of items to food bank.
