WEST COAST PLAY



During recess and lunchtime breaks, students are expected to be outside at all times this year. Students are strongly encouraged to dress appropriately for the weather. To be prepared to be outside in the rain it is important for

your child to have appropriate clothing such as:

- A rain jacket
- o Rubber boots
- Rain pants
- o An umbrella
- \circ $\,$ A rain hat or coat with a hood
- *A change of clothes to be kept at school (sweatpants, underwear, socks, t-shirt, etc.)
- When students use their change of clothes, please send another set to school for the next time.

EXTENDED ABSENCES

During the year students may be absent from school for an extended period of time. It is district policy that students may only be absent for 4 (four)



consecutive weeks and retain their place in the school. After 4 weeks, students will be removed from the school register. Upon returning, students will have to reregister at the school board office. If we have space, your child will be placed in a class, but not necessarily the class they left. It will take a few days for your child to be placed, so he/she <u>cannot begin school on the day you</u> return. If Whiteside is full, the district will find space in the nearest available school. Teachers will not provide work for students on extended absences. *Our extended absence form needs to be completed if you are planning an absence for a week or longer.*

ALLERGY ALERT:

All families should be aware that Whiteside School has many students with severe, life-threatening food allergies. Some classrooms may be designated nut

free in order to protect the health of these students. Please help us limit the nut products entering our school overall, as the impact on a student can happen anywhere in the school. If at all possible, please do not send food to school containing nuts.



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LATE ENTRY & ABSENCES

We understand that things happen in the morning that can derail your normal routines. If students are late in the morning, please ring the -

doorbell and wait at the main door. A member of our staff will greet the students and bring them to their class. All family members must remain outside.

If you know your child will be away, please call the school office and leave a message at any time (604-668-6209 or 604-668-6154). You can also email absences to <u>whiteside@sd38.bc.ca</u>. Informing the office will prevent unnecessary calls home. Thank you!



PARKING LOT SAFETY

Please help keep our students safe by using the drop off zone for picking up and dropping off students only. *Please do not leave your car unattended in the drop off zone or park in staff parking spots*; if you need to come into the school, please park in a parking space closer to

South Arm Community Centre. When walking to school, please use the designated paths south and adjacent to the driveway as you enter the school grounds. Please follow arrows to keep our students safe and keep our parking lot accident free.

Please remember the east parking lot is for school and construction staff only. Please do not park or drop off children in this area.
