If Whiteside is full, the district will find space in the nearest available school. Teachers will not provide work for students on extended absences. Our extended absence form needs to be completed if you are planning an absence for a week or longer.

After winter break, we will open our gym for students to join staff, teachers, and student leaders for a morning snack and play time in


the gym. More information to come in the new year.

PARKING LOT SAFETY: A FRIENDLY REMINDER



Drop-off and pick-up times can get hectic! Let's work together to keep our parking lot safe for everyone. Please remember these important points:

- Drive slowly and cautiously: Children can be unpredictable, so always be alert and watch for pedestrians.
- Use designated visitor parking spaces only: Do not park in the fire lane or drive-thru lane, as this blocks traffic flow and creates hazards.
- Hold your child's hand: Always supervise young children and hold their hands when walking through the parking lot.
- Be aware of your surroundings: Look for moving vehicles and be mindful of blind spots when backing up.

STUDENT AFFORDABILITY FUND

Recently, the provincial government announced a new, one time <u>Student</u> <u>and Family Affordability Fund</u>. This fund is designed to assist families who require financial assistance with
