#### **DIGITAL DEVICE POLICY**

# PARKING LOT SAFETY: A FRIENDLY REMINDER

Drop-off and pick-up times can get hectic! Let's work together to keep our parking lot safe for everyone. Please remember these important points:



- Drive slowly and cautiously: Children can be unpredictable, so always be alert and watch for pedestrians.
- Use designated visitor parking spaces only: Do not park in the fire lane or drive-thru lane, as this blocks traffic flow and creates hazards.
- *Hold your child's hand*: Always supervise young children and hold their hands when walking through the parking lot.
- *Be aware of your surroundings*: Look for moving vehicles and be mindful of blind spots when backing up.



# WEST COAST PLAY
