This includes during recess and lunch or while outside on the playground or on school property. It is recommended that students do not bring personal digital devices to school.

PARKING LOT SAFETY: A FRIENDLY REMINDER

Drop-off and pick-up times can get hectic! Let's work together to keep our parking lot safe for everyone. Please remember these important points:



- Drive slowly and cautiously: Children can be unpredictable, so always be alert and watch for pedestrians.
- Use designated visitor parking spaces only: Do not park in the fire lane or drive-thru lane, as this blocks traffic flow and creates hazards.
- Hold your child's hand: Always supervise young children and hold their hands when walking through the parking lot.
- *Be aware of your surroundings*: Look for moving vehicles and be mindful of blind spots when backing up.
